Overview: On 30 August 2018, a CMC Safety Division, Semper Ride, Motorcycling the Right Way, event will be held at MCB Quantico. The location for this event is Barnett Field and its parking lot.

There will be two presentation sessions that are meant to increase a motorcycle rider's safety awareness and decision-making. Videos and guest speakers will be used to deliver the messages along with interactive question and answer sessions.

Guest speakers for this event are:

- Ronnie Renner, 10-time X Games Gold Medalist
- Jason Pridmore, World Sportbike Racing Champion and owner of JP43 Training (Formerly Star School)

A Poker Run will take place for all licensed motorcycle riders.

Additionally, a MCCS motorcycle expo will take place at the event featuring motorcycles, riding gear, insurance experts, local traffic safety pros and other relevant items from both local and national companies and entities.

The expo will also include a high-flying Freestyle Motocross demonstration featuring top professional riders.

This event is open to all military members and civilian DOD employees.
