WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THIS PROGRAM?

All active duty service members and their eligible family members who are expecting a child or with children under six years old are eligible to participate free of charge in all of the services offered.

WHAT CAN THE NEW PARENT SUPPORT PROGRAM DO FOR ME?

This program offers expectant parents and parents of children 0-5 the opportunity to learn new skills as a parent and improve old ones. There are often many questions about the needs of infants and young children, and NPSP is a reliable source for those answers.
